Individuals using e-transfers are asked to use only the password prayer. (Please <u>DO NOT use other passwords</u> as it makes processing the e-transfers less efficient. -- *Thanks*, - *Jude*.) *Another (and easier) way is by pre-authorised remittance (P.A.R.). This can be set up through the church office, and means no further action needs to be taken by you, as long as you wish payments to continue.*
